At Ivegill Primary School, we have designed our EYFS curriculum to ensure that children are prepared to enter KS1. We provide the children with the key knowledge, understanding and skills which will aid their learning as they progress into Year 1. Below are some examples of how the EYFS curriculum supports further learning in KS1.

<i>In EYFS we learn about...</i>	<i>So that in KS1 we...</i>
<p>Ourselves, our emotions, people in our families, how we are all different and special.</p> <p>Our life story so far – important events in our lives.</p> <p>People in our community – how they help us, and why their jobs are important.</p>	<p>Can reflect on our relationships, set ourselves goals, discuss our dreams and goals and celebrate our differences. (PSHE).</p> <p>Discuss changes in living memory, the lives of people and places in our own locality. (History).</p>
<p>Processes in the natural world – how the weather and local environment change during each season.</p>	<p>Can share our knowledge of seasonal changes. (Science)</p>
<p>Animals and their habitats, camouflage and features.</p> <p>The life cycles of animals, plants and humans.</p>	<p>Can identify and name a variety of common animals and their classifications. (Science)</p> <p>Notice that animals, including humans have offspring which grow into adults. (Science)</p> <p>Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals for survival. (Science)</p> <p>Identify that most living things live in habitats, and how they are suited to their needs. (Science)</p>

<p>Plants and how they grow from a seed.</p> <p>The features of a plant (roots and shoots).</p> <p>What plants need to grow and stay healthy.</p>	<p>Can identify and name a variety of common and wild garden plants and trees. (Science)</p> <p>Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants, and what they need to grow and stay healthy. (Science)</p>
<p>Our houses and where we live.</p> <p>Features of our local area (both Ivegill and Carlisle).</p> <p>Why we use maps, and our location on maps of the UK and the World.</p> <p>The similarities and differences between hot and cold places around the world.</p> <p>Compare life in other countries around the world</p>	<p>Locate the world's seven continents and five oceans. Name and locate the four countries and capital cities of the UK. (Geography).</p> <p>Understand geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography of the UK and contrasting countries. (Geography).</p> <p>Use basic geographical vocabulary, world maps, atlases, globes and participate in simple fieldwork. (Geography).</p>
<p>Celebrations (Birthdays, Harvest, Bonfire, Diwali, Christmas, Easter etc...)</p>	<p>Have an awareness of religions and celebrations around the World. (RE).</p> <p>Learn about significant historical events. (History).</p> <p>Have an understanding of Harvest and why that is important in our school community.</p>

How to take care of ourselves and others. Ways to stay healthy	Know how we grow and what we need to grow healthily. (Science/PSHE).
Holidays in the past and present. Holidays in our country or abroad.	Can share our knowledge of what life was like in the past and study other relevant changes. (History). Talk about other countries in the world, and use maps and atlases to locate them. (Geography).
Learn and explore different techniques and skills to produce our own artwork, inspired by famous artists. Learn about primary colours and basic colour mixing. Use a range of techniques to build and make models.	Use a range of materials to design and make products. (DT) Use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share ideas. (Art). Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line etc... (Art). Discuss the work of a range of artists and designers. Describing the differences and similarities between different disciplines. (Art).
RE: To hear the stories Jesus told, introduce the Bible, learn about Jesus's miracles, discuss why we are special, find out about celebrations and special places. Introduce Christianity and other religions around the World. Learn about Harvest, Christmas and Easter.	RE: Learn about the key celebrations in the Christian Faith. Learn in more detail about the Bible, special places, prayer, symbols and why Jesus was special. Have an awareness of other faiths and the lives of people around the World.
